Show desk must be informed of desire for combining classes at least two classes prior to the combined classes being run. Show management will also call additional breaks, if required.

#### **IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION:**

- All horses entering fair grounds must present an original negative Coggins test dated within one year of show date in order to enter. A Louisiana State Certified EIA inspector will be at the gate and will request your Coggins tests for all horses in your trailer.
- All out-of-state horses must present a current health certificate for horse show or an equine health passport.
- You must present original or copy of horse(s) registration papers (front and back) and your 2013 National ApHC membership card at the show desk.
- All exhibitors and at least one horse owner listed on horse's registration papers MUST be a current (2013) member of the Appaloosa Horse Club, Inc., Moscow, Idaho, and MUST present current (2013) membership card or copy of current (2013) membership card at the show desk or must purchase membership at the show desk prior to showing. This is a national ApHC rule.
- You must be a member of the Louisiana State Appaloosa Club if you wish to earn points for Louisiana State Appaloosa Club's year-end awards.

Please note: POINTS DO NOT COUNT UNTIL YOU BECOME A MEMBER. If you want to earn year-end points, be sure to join the club **before** showing!

# **RULES. POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

#### **SHOW RULES**

- Registered Show rules: Registered shows will use the current ApHC Official Handbook.
- Show Awards: The LSAC will provide ribbons to the winners in each class. A set of ribbons will be awarded for each judge.
- Class sponsors: Only one sponsor allowed per class. Sponsorship fee is \$100 for the year. The sponsor will be announced at the shows prior to the class and will be listed in the Annual Program Guide.

## LSAC POINT SYSTEM

- Registered Show LSAC Class Points: The first place entry will receive 1 point for every entry in the class, up to a maximum of 5 points. The second place entry will receive one point less than the 1<sup>st</sup> entry and so on down to the fifth place entry which will receive 1 point.
- Grand and Reserve Points at Halter: In addition to the class points the Grand Champion in each division shall receive 2 points and the Reserve Champion shall receive 1 point.

#### YEAR-END HIGH POINT AWARDS

(Revised 1-15-11)

1. Awards: The club will present High-Point Awards each year to the following categories:

**High Point Halter Horse** (points accumulated from the following classes: All Halter Classes and all Most Colorful Classes including Youth, Non-Pro and Open.) Points are accumulated on a single horse. This is not a team award.

High Point Western Performance Horse (points accumulated from the following classes: All Open Western Performance Classes including Showmanship and all Open Timed Events.) One Horse and One Rider Team.

**High Point English Performance Horse** (points accumulated from the following classes: All Open English Performance Classes including Hunter in Hand) One Horse and One Rider Team.

High Point Non-Pro Exhibitor (Points accumulated from the following classes: All Non-Pro classes except Non-Pro Halter and Non-Pro Most Colorful.) One Horse and One Rider Team.

High Point Youth 18 & Under (points

accumulated from all Youth Classes including Novice that contain a lope or canter.) One Horse and One Rider Team.

**High Point Youth Walk/Trot.** (points accumulated from all Youth Classes including Novice that does not contain a lope or canter.) One Horse and One Rider Team.

**High Point Equestrian with Disabilities:** Points will be accumulated from two classes. One Class, pattern to be set for the year, for equestrians that require the assistance of 1 or more helpers to complete their class. And one class, pattern to be set for the year, for equestrians that do not require the assistance of a helper. Both classes will be pointed according to a point system as set forth by LSAC.

 High Point Year-End Awards: High Point Year-End awards will be presented in each division and class approved by the board to the participant who has met the eligibility requirements and has earned the highest number of points in that division or class.

- 3. Eligibility: To be eligible for Year-End awards a horse and exhibitor must show in the same class in at least 50% of the LSAC Sponsored, cosponsored, or co-pointed shows including at least one show held within the state of Louisiana. Points and show eligibility do not count until the horse owner and exhibitor is a member of the LSAC.
- 4. Sponsorships: Sponsorships for Year-End class Awards or High Point awards are \$100 or the assessed value of the award. Sponsors should notify the LSAC President of their interest in sponsoring an award by November 1<sup>st</sup>. Sponsors will be recognized at the Award Banquet and, if they desire, can present the award to the recipient.
- 5. **Tie-Breaker:** 1<sup>st</sup> Tie breaker: The horse/rider team that competes in the most performance classes meeting the eligibility criteria will be awarded that high point. 2<sup>nd</sup> Tie Breaker: The horse/rider team placing highest in the most classes. 3<sup>rd</sup> Tie Breaker: If still tied after both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> tie breakers, flip of a coin will determine.

#### **GUIDELINES**

# LSAC's ApHC WORLD SHOW NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- LSAC will require members desiring a World Show nomination to submit in writing a request for nomination, specifying the owner's name, horse's name, and class to be nominated. The requests must be received by the secretary of the club by July 15. An email request can fulfill this obligation.
- LSAC will nominate the maximum number of horses in each class allowed by the National Club which meet the minimum requirements set forth by the ApHC.
- If there are more horses qualified to be nominated in a specific class than allowed that year by ApHC, then the LSAC point system will be used to determine who is nominated.

These guidelines are to be publicized to the membership in the LSAC program guide and in the newsletter prior to the deadline for nomination requests. The committee believes that nominating the maximum horses allowed is in the best interest of the club and attracts more exhibitors to our shows.
